

CAREER *outcomes rate*




TOP *employers*





pandemic IMPACT

In the wake of COVID-19, the Class of 2020 began their careers in an unfamiliar employment landscape. Yet, despite the economic downturn, **94%** of the class of 2020 secured first destination opportunities within 6 months of graduation, compared to **96%** of the class of 2019.


Alumnae, staff, and faculty all joined together to strongly support seniors in navigating their transitions. Over **300 alumnae** provided direct mentorship to seniors through Career Education's Senior Support Network. This sheet outlines some key outcome comparisons and emerging trends.

CAREER OUTCOMES comparison




doctoral degree PURSUITS

Of the students going to graduate school immediately following graduation, 41.49% pursued doctoral degrees in 2020, compared with 27.96% for the class of 2019 (includes Ph.D, M.D., J.D., and other equivalent doctoral programs)
