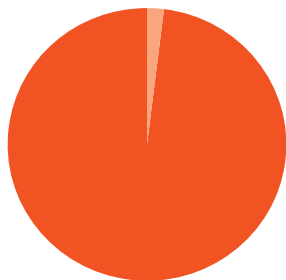

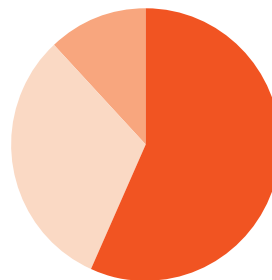

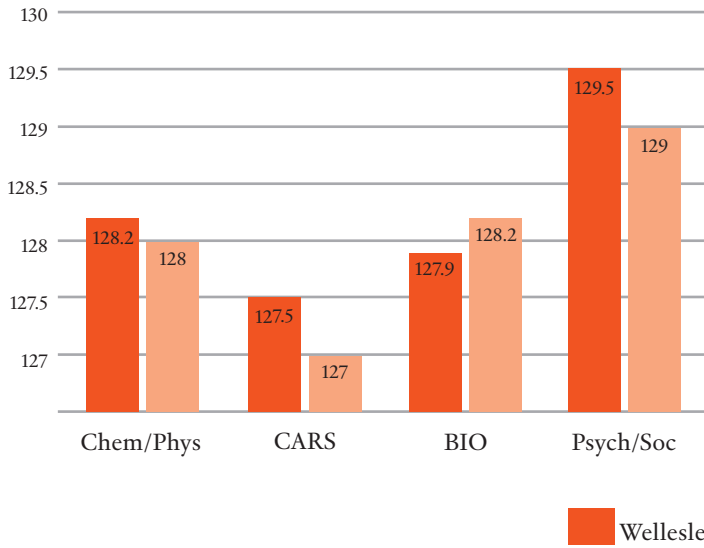

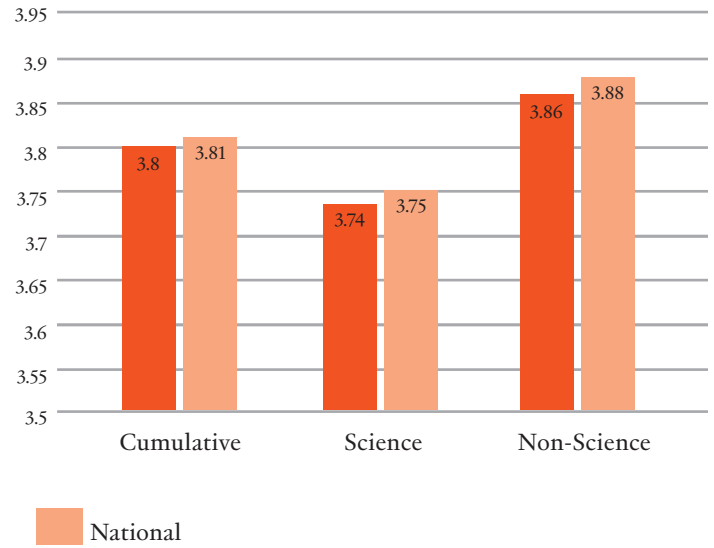

Wellesley vs. National Average

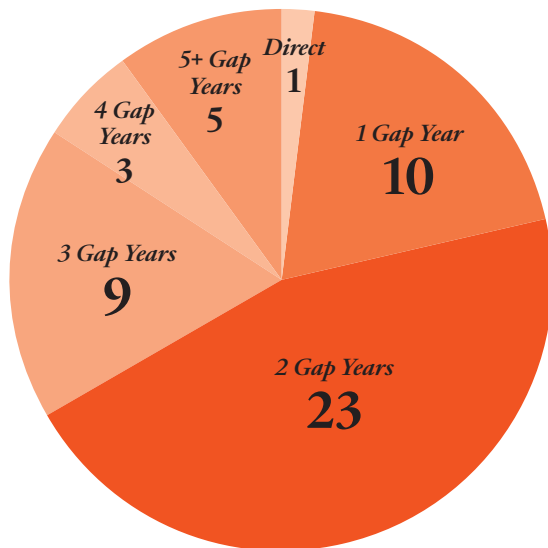


GPA Accepted MD Students
Wellesley vs. National Average

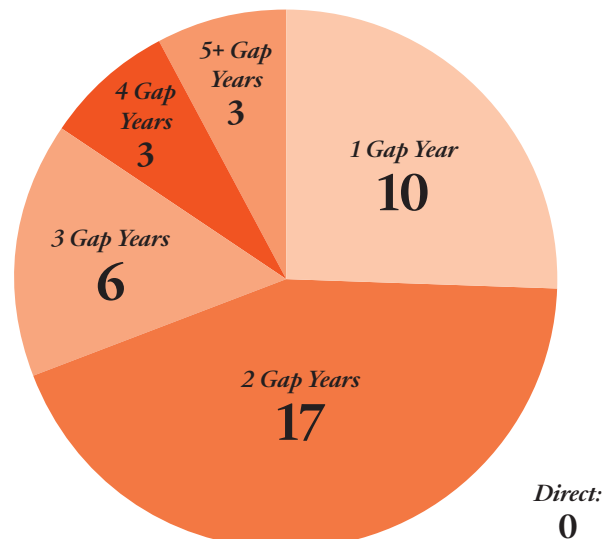

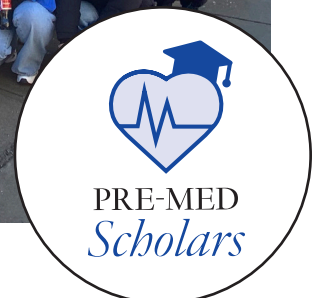
